2012 Sonoma Coast Sangiacomo Vineyard

Fresh, vibrant notes of dark red cherry, cranberry and rose pedals are enhanced by a bright acidity making this Pinot crisp and refreshing. Layers of rich stone fruit and berry flavors are interwoven with sweet oak and earthy tannins resulting in a delicately balanced complex wine - great to enjoy by itself or with a light meal. The sumptuous mouth feel is quite lush considering the bright acidity and structure.

At Chloe Creek Vineyards, our mission is to create distinctive, limited-production vineyard designate Pinot Noirs that showcase the true expression and complexity of the vineyard. We appreciate great food and wine and the lifestyle that comes with growing and making Pinots of exceptional quality.

Because world-class wine begins in world-class vineyards, our grapes are harvested only from the best Sonoma County Appellation vineyards. The Sangiacomo Roberts Road block planted in 1998 benefits from cool stream of air drawn in from San Pablo Bay located in the footprint of Copeland Creek in the Petaluma Gap and comprised of a combination of alluvial soil and gravel.
